About Enrych Bucks:

Enrych Bucks is a charity that enables adults with physical or sensory disabilities to participate in leisure or learning activities. This is through either a volunteer to support an activity or with the facilitation to join a local group of that person's choosing.

Enrych Bucks look to recruit volunteers specifically for each of their members depending on choice of activity and location.

How has Community Impact Bucks helped?

Community Impact Bucks is commissioned by Buckinghamshire County Council to deliver the Volunteer Hub for Prevention Matters to recruit volunteers for groups and organisations supporting older and vulnerable adults.

"The Volunteer Hub has referred many volunteers to Enrych Bucks. They are also very supportive in getting our name out and known locally. Enrych Bucks is a very small charity so it is imperative Community Impact Bucks know of us and help spread the word.

Due to help received, of those who have completed the recruitment process in 2014 and are volunteering with us, 5 have come through the xchangeBucks website and 6 directly from the Volunteer Hub enabling 11 clients to participate in activities they previously wouldn't have been able to join in with, thus having an impact on the mood and health of the client and improved social isolation."
